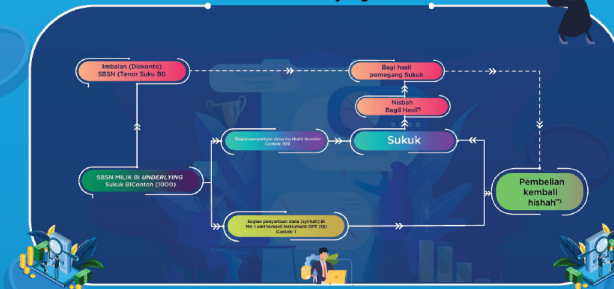

Ambulance – 118

The city provides free ambulance service for residents holding Jakarta ID cards through the hotline 118, which is run by a unit of the Health Agency. The service is provided for free to Jakarta residents, non-Jakarta ID holders pay Rp 300,000 (US\$23) per trip

Police – 110

The National Police have provided an emergency call number, 110, which can be contacted 24-hours-a-day.

Health – 119

Launched by Jakarta administration in March 2013, the 119 call center is aimed at helping residents find out about available health facilities, including vacant hospital rooms and ambulance services around the city

Information – 108

Hotline 108 provides general information, including the phone numbers of hospitals, embassy offices, pharmacies, clinics and key agencies and institutions, including the National Commission for Human Rights (Komnas HAM), the Legal Aid Institute (LBH) and the Indonesian Consumers Foundation (YLKI)
